- PO Box unusually provided free to residents living in areas without home delivery
- Identified by vendors, not the USPS (typically proprietary)
- Methods could differ among vendors.
- How do we know if the vendors are correct?









# Roundabout plans returned for more study

Plans for the proposed roundabout on Stockton Hill Road north of Interstate 40, connecting Beverly Avenue and the on/off ramps, have been returned for additional design study, according to the Arizona Department of Transportation.

ADOT's Bruce Purrier said the country's top roundabout specialist, Peter Doctors, has been asked to analyze the design and determine how the roundahout will work in lems if traffic is backed into the to clear. roundabout.

To work properly, traffic must flow freely once it enters the roundabout.

Purrier describes the roundabout as a 50 foot-wide roadway without lane markers. All drivers will have to yield at entrances into the roundabout and have right-of-way only after getting into the circle.

# Postal Service says 'no' to home delivery in Arizona city of 10,000

PAGE (AP) - This city has been trying to do something about it, through rain and shine and blowing dust devils, for 15 years,

But the mailman never delivers.

The post office in this municipality of 10,000 people is bigger than those of many large cities. It has 4,350 boxes, a snarl of traffic every day and enough gossip for a dozen cafes. But it still doesn't have home mail delivery.

Page Mayor Robert Bowling just doesn't get it. His is a nice, compact, orderly little town where even the churches are lined up in a row on Lake Powell Boulevard. In other words, a great place to deliver mail.

"It's interesting that although we pay the

same postage as the rest of the U.S., our level of service is not the same," Bowling said. "I suppose the concepts of equality can be set aside when convenient for the U.S. Postal Service."

Don't blame it on Uncle Sam, Page Postmaster Bob Schlesinger said.

The U.S. Postal Service acknowledges that regulations require it to make home delivery of mail in towns of more than 2,500 population, said Peter Haas, a Postal Service spokesman. He says Page is one of the few cities in the country - San Luis, Ariz., is another - of 10,000 or more people with no home mail delivery.

The city had its opportunity three years

ago when the post office offered to make the rounds. But Schlesinger said the Postal Service wanted mailboxes on the side of the street where carriers wouldn't have to leave their vehicles to stuff the boxes.

The problem in Page is that there is only the slightest of gaps between the curbs and sidewalks and the boxes would have protruded slightly into the street.

City officials decided they didn't want the liability of skateboarders and motorists running into boxes on city right-of-way.

Neither did they want to worry about mail trucks striking someone on the sidewalks.

Former Page Mayor James Sippel rolls

his eyes at the memory of it all.

"Finally, the post office just said ... 'forget about it," Sippel said. "Everyone here is just consumed with liability. The liability of delivering mail. The liability of breathing. Whatever."

Not everyone in town is up in arms. For many residents, the post office serves as a town square, a gathering place for socializing and small talk.

"A lot of us in town don't want home delivery," said Barbara Larssen, 67, a Page resident who moved from Massachusetts 11 years ago.

She lingered at her box for about 15 minutes, chatting with people passing by.

"I came because it's a small town. I'm still able to get up and go and I like running into people down here," Larssen said.

For others, the trip is more chore than

"It sure would be nice to walk outside your door to a mailbox," said Elaine Schulz. a longtime librarian in Page. "Those of us who come down here also find ourselves picking up mail for a lot of other people."

Richard Jentzsch, Page's assistant city manager, said he has been involved during 12 of the city's 15 years of trying to get home-mail delivery.

"The Postal Service has been negative about it the whole 12 years," Jentzsch said

- Improved Coverage of Households
- Reduced Potential for Coverage Bias
  - Small in number but clustered
  - Unlikely to have meaningful impact on national coverage
  - Could have large coverage implications for community surveys
